- Donna Thomas shares the Church of Scientology is offering self improvement courses and recently trained new staff and are now expanding their programs. Pam reports on a communication course being offered. All are welcome to attend.
- Dave Gould of St. Francis reports they are getting ready for Lent and St. Patrick's Day dinner.

• Guest: Adam Peacocke of Feathervine

Comes to bring an update in regards to work happening with County of Sonoma Emergency Management of and Office of Equity. See handouts to follow. This year they are doing resource mapping with the churches in the county. They sat down with faith leaders and asked how the disasters since 2017 have impacted their congregations and your community, how did you help and how can you help in the future? Faith based communities want to help and want to be prepared. When we collaborate we can be more effective. Resource mapping can help us recognize gaps and opportunities to stand together for the good of the community.

Why resource mapping? Planning for better and more equitable disaster preparation, response and recovery. When disaster strike the marginalized communities are impacted most. Based on listening sessions faith based contributions are worth mapping. Between now and June they are going to send out a survey link to a Google form asking what type of community engagement are you offering already outside of disasters. What does your faith community offer such as food distributions, donation collections, financial support etc. Please respond timely to the upcoming email and survey. Between June and December we will do another listening series and presentation with a more planned and coordinated response plan. Sonoma County Community Organizations Active in Disaster (COAD) is participating. Sonoma County has been involved in more disasters than many other CA counties. They have created a space in the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) for other organizations such as COAD and would like faith based organizations to have a seat in the EOC. Deacon Dave is helping with that and they are also looking for volunteers to help with communications. Lisa offers that the Episcopal church has a statewide plan that is something that could be linked and accessed, perhaps your church or leadership has similar information for emergency plans to share with Adam to coordinate with the county. Shir Shalom is doing something similar and they may also share when completed.
